

EXCERPTS FROM A FAMILY HISTORY

Recorded in the year 1937 by Emma Eberhard and preserved by her niece, Georgiana Eberhard Brune, a great granddaughter of Mary Cornelia Burbidge.

Grandmother was Mary Cornelia Burbidge, born in Hartford, Connecticut, April 25, 1816. She was the youngest daughter and second child of Lieut. Charles and Rhoda (Wolcott) Burbidge. Four children were in the family: Maria, born in 1812 or 1813, Cornelia, William Henry and Charles. Charles died in infancy. As a child Cornelia and a little neighbor girl played with their dolls under the Charter Oak Tree in Hartford and ate the little acorns. She learned to knit very early and also to sew.

At twelve years of age her mother and older sister died of typhoid or typhus fever, and she went from Connecticut to New York City to live with her father's youngest sister, Cornelia (Burbidge) Hyatt, whose husband was a jeweler doing business, I think, on Nassau Street. Her brother William went to live with his mother's sister, a Mrs. Russell. Her aunt Mary (Burbidge) Huntington had expected to give her a home in Connecticut, but after she was there a few weeks, her aunt Cornelia Hyatt persuaded Aunt Mary Huntington to let her take young Cornelia to New York, where she would "educate and make a lady of her": which she did not do. Instead, Cornelia took care of her aunt's three boys while Aunt kept up with society, which Grandmother Cornelia very much resented. She had left school in Connecticut before she learned the multiplication tables, but as girls were not taught much in arithmetic and she was a good reader, an extra-good speller, an excellent seamstress and well-started in geography, she could manage very well without much "in figures". They taught one branch at a time in those days. Spelling came first, and no attempt was made to read until one could spell every word of the "spellin! book"; then reading was added, then geography and a little arithmetic. Eut all the time the girls were taking sewing, and boys and girls did not go to the same school. Grandmother remembered the talk about Lucy Stone as "the women who wanted to be a man" because she went to college. She went to school with "Fanny Fern" and Harriet Beecher Stowe, and Catherine Beecher was one of her teachers.

She apprenticed herself to a dressmaker and learned the trade. July 19, 1837 she married William Clarke Tillotson in New York City. He was a diamond setter and a partner of her uncle John Hyatt. During the financial panic of 1836 and 1837 and for a few years following, the business suffered great reverses on account of the many wild speculations in cheap land made by the partner John Hyatt, and both failed. Hyatt stayed in New York, in his old shop, earning \$2.50 per day chasing rings at which he was an expert. He used a little hammer, and he had used it so well and for so long that the handle had the prints of his thumb and finger worn into it. He worked until the gold rush in 1849; he went to California to "pan gold" but was taken with dysentery at once and died.

Tillotson, with his wife and two children, made his way west in 1841, hoping to find some of the land his father—in—law had filed claim to during the various Indian Wars in which he had been engaged. Not being successful, he left his wife and children boarding with a Mormon woman and went south thinking that he might find some work at his craft, since much of his work in New York City had come from the South. But before he had time to find

anything he was taken with a fever and was six weeks in a hospital in New Orleans. While there he made inquiry concerning the "speculation land" in which his partner had invested the firm's money. He was told much of it was swamps while some was "mountain tops with rattlesnakes enough to fence it." After many weeks absence he returned to a very worried wife whose trunk of table linens and bed linen, jewelry and clothing had been retained for board, and the landlady refused to let them redeem it.

They lived in or near the city of Quincy, Illinois until coming to Kansas in May 1854. My mother was fourteen years old that fall, November 4, 1854. She was the oldest girl and very responsible, and so she felt much of the hardships and privations, but not to be compared with that of the father's and mother's share.

They crossed the Missouri River at St. Joseph on the ferry and camped for dinner on the bank of a little creek. The first night in Kansas was spent at Wathena, a little Indian village with a few white settlers who lived in bark houses. It was in one of these bark houses that they stayed during a rain and were surprised to find it so dry. These houses were made by peeling the bark from cottonwood trees and standing it up like an Indian wigwam.

The first year they saw but two white women; one stopped for the night as the family passed through to another settlement, the other a French woman with whom they could neighbor but little; but the next year a white family came to live near. The Indians were friendly and often visited them; perhaps called upon would be more nearly correct, for their visits were always brief. They always wanted to "swap" and did not tarry long, and, aside from frightening the children, they would not have been unwelcome had they not been such beggars. They wanted to swap for just about everything they saw, including the blue-eyed baby. They were usually given whatever they wanted, for Grandmother was afraid of offending them, but she drew the line at the baby. Whenever they came in the house, Mary and her sister Felle would both get hold of that baby to brotect her. The Indians were very fond of watermelon and Grandfather usually raised them. They made their wishes known by gestures, grunts and a few words, as few as possible. One time a young squaw tied four large melons in her blanket, and to the amazement of all put them on her head, mounted her pony and rode away. One day while Mary and Belle were on the way to Sunday School, near Ozewkie, going along the pony trail through the prairie grass almost as high as their heads, they looked behind them and saw an Indian on his pony coming over a little rise, flourishing his whip, riding as fast as he could make his pony go. They were terribly frightened and ran as fast as they could, but of course he soon overtook them. Imagine their relief when, without slackening his pace, he said "How!" and passed on; all the while they had expected to be scalped.

A little over a year after reaching their cabin home, while Grandfather and the older boy, Frank, were away hauling Government supplies from Ft. Leavenworth to Ft. Riley, a new baby came. There was no doctor nearer than Leavenworth and no one to send for him, only the lone white neighbor woman. And when the baby was but a day or two old, and before Grandfather returned, some Indians had gotten whiskey and were well drunken. They came in the middle of the night, riding their ponies on the gallop, round and round the cabin, calling "Howdy do, white man! Howdy do, white man!" The little dog, named Jack, scenting danger, backed against the door and barked savagely and as hard as he could. They were truly frightened in that small room, but the Indians, receiving

no answer and thinking perhaps the cabin was deserted, became tired after a time (which seemed hours) and rode away without dismounting. A day or two before this the Indians had passed the cabin with kegs on their ponies, and Grandmother knew that they were going for whiskey. This was the only time that they were ever disturbed in any way by the Indians.

They were driven from the house one night, or early morning, in February 1856, by high water. Grandfather watched the creek rise all night, and, fearing that it would reach the house, he took the precaution of tying a raft that he had constructed near. As early as they could see to cross he loaded bedding and the family on the raft and paddled out to a sheltered place on the bluff out of danger of the water. They lived in one covered wagon and cooked by a campfire for two weeks. The flood water reached the comb of the house. Freezing over, it froze the chickens' feet that had flown to the house top to escape the water. They were rescued by Frank skating over to them and taking them out. In this flood they lost everything in the house that water could destroy; some things—books were mentioned—floated out and scattered all through the woods down the creek. All the corn they had raised and stored, which they had shelled and had ground that it might more easily be hauled to Lecompton, also was lost. Grandfather had tried to haul it earlier, but the roads were so slippery the oxen could not stand and pull a load. This corn was to make payment on the place, and deferred payments called for 30% interest.

When they raised cattle and hogs to sell, they had to be driven to market, to Atchison or Leavenworth. (The farm they settled on was just north of Ozawkie, Kansas. The "creek" that flooded them out was the Delaware River, or, as it was called then, "Grasshopper Greek".) Several men usually sold together, and when they drove hogs to market, a wagon accompanied to pick up any hogs that gave out. Grandfather sometimes butchered his hogs before marketing, and then he received 10¢ a pound. The year of the Land Sale the people of Ozawkie sold drinking water and it cost almost as much as a drink of whiskey. They had one year of great drouth (1860?) and several crop failures. Mother remembers they expected to get \$1 per bushel for the corn they lost but does not remember the price of ear corn (ground). They sold many bushels a few years later for 30¢. A cow was near \$30, and their horses that were stolen at the outbreak of the Civil War were valued at \$100 each. Mother remembered paying 50¢ per yard for calico during the Civil War.

When the summer became hot and dry they burned around their buildings and hay stacks or plowed several furrows around them to protect them from prairie fires, and they lost very little from fires, but they saw and helped fight several. When these fires got started in the tall grass, they burned faster than a horse could gallop. They lost only one team of horses by raiders early in the War. The Battle of Hickory Point was fought only a few miles away, and one store was raided and one burned in Valley Falls (Grasshoper Falls as it was called then). These things so near, and the report of depradations made life full of anxiety and fearful of what might happen. Frank enlisted in the 7th Cavalry.

In 1861 they dug a well and built a new log house somewhat larger than the old one and to which they later added a kitchen. This house still stands, and, I think, is occupied. (A note from Georgiana Brune: "The house was sided

up and later used for a granary. When the Perry Dam was built, the land was taken by the Government and my husband and I bought the old house. He ripped off the siding and we took pictures of the log cabin undermeath, then brought some of the best logs home and some of the old home-made bricks.").

Grandmother was a little woman and afraid of so many things like staying alone, afraid of storms and animals and many other things. (She was afraid of a cow, and if she had to milk one when her husband had the ague, she milked standing off at arm's length, trembling all the time.). She was used to many of the luxuries of the times in the East, but I heard her say that she was never happier in her life than when she lived in a log cabin on a ground floor, and the children still insist they had as much fun and real pleasures as the youngsters today. I cannot help adding: I wonder, as I look around at the conditions today, etc., how many of this generation of today appreciate what this nation has cost.

An excerpt from the newspaper "The American Desert", Millbrook, Kansas, 1 May 1887, page 1, quoting from an earlier issue of the "Toledo Blade":

Chew! Chew! Chew! It has become a national habit, and he or she who has not a mouthful of gum or tobacco upon which the energies are is an exception. In social gatherings, on the street car, at public entertainments, it is the same everlasting wagging of the chin. Wax figures of the people of the present will be made a thousand years from now with a perpetual motion machine hidden in the mouth to keep the jaws moving in order to be a realistic representation. The figure would be a caricature without it. Happy is the gum manufacturer in this day and generation, for the cry is still for more of his products. Refined women can rival the most inveterate tobacco chewers in their power of chewing. Like the flowing of Tennyson's "Brook" their jaws wag on "forever".



A Letter from Mrs. William Brown, Box 325, Paola, Kansas, 66071, enclosing a most interesting contribution for The Pioneer:

You say in The Pioneer that you would like contributions. If you think this letter would be of general interest I would be glad to have you use it. The original letter is still in the possession of William Brown's family. He returned to Wisconsin for his wife and daughter (both of whom are listed in the Register of Old Settlers Meeting). They settled in Osage County, first in the Lickskillet neighborhood then near Carbondale. He freighted Government supplies to Forts in Kansas, Fort Kearney in Nebraska and Julesburg, Colorado. He dug and sold coal from his own land, farmed, raised stock and built a fine house. He had another daughter and two sons.

Letter from William Brown of Monroe, Green County, Wisconsin to his wife, Clarissa Silver of Mt. Pleasant, Green County, Wisconsin.

Leavenworth, Nov. the 1, 1858 Dear Clara.

At long last we have got to Kansas. Today we crossed the Missouri River at Weston and are camped by the government farm I mile north of the fort. I have seen nothing worthy of so much notice as slavery in my travels. If Mrs. Stowe lacks any thing of setting it forth in its true colors a trip through Missouri will complete the work. If you wish to gain a knowledge of slavery you must not sit down and listen to a proslavery man but talk to Cuff himself. It is extremely dangerous however to be caught talking to a slave being against their law. I for one transgressed that law repeatedly.

Nov. the 7th, 1858

Today is Sunday and raining all the forenoon and pretty much all last week. It is about three o'clock now and has some signs of clearing off. We have bought some wood on an island 6 miles above Leavenworth and we are going rafting to that place. We get it for \$1.00 and sell it for four and five dollars. I shall be at this business long enough to get a letter from you which I trust you will send as quick as you can. I have not been out in the territory yet. The city is one of the finest places considering its age that have ever seen. It covers more than a half section and contains twelve thousand inhabitants. Three years ago it was a wilderness. Direct your letter to Leavenworth City, Kans. If I was there I could think of enough to fill twenty such sheets of paper, but I will leave you to guess at the balance and quit. This is all.

The Library has the following editions: 1860/1, 1866, 1871, 1875/6, 1879, 1883, 1886, 1888, 1890/91, 1893/94, 1896, 1898, 1900/01, 1902/3, 1905, 1907, 1908/9, 1911, 1913/4, 1915, 1917, 1919, 1923, 1925/6, 1927/8, 1929/30; (Note: none published 1931-1960); 1961, 1963, 1964, 1966, 1969, 1970, and 1972 to present. Note that the city directories for 1890 and 1893 also contain listings of rural residents of Douglas County. The Library also has local phone books for 1916, 1933, 1936, and 1941 to the present.

The Library at present (March 1978) has the Lawrence Journal World on microfilm from 1946 to the present, but it has on order the years 1911-1946. It is the Library's goal to acquire all Lawrence papers, but for now patrons

must go to the University of Kansas Library.

Census microfilm includes only the Federal census of 1860, 1870 and 1880

for Douglas County.

At this point it should be mentioned that the Documents Library at the University of Kansas has just completed a most useful collection of Census microfilms. The Documents Library now has a complete set of the U. S. Federal Censuses of 1860, 1870 and 1880 for Kansas. In addition to the Federal Census, the State of Kansas took its own census (with the same data as the Federal, in the listing of each individual, age, etc.) from 1865 to 1925. These State censuses are very valuable, particularly for the years 1885 and 1895 (owing to the loss of the 1890 Federal census). The Documents Library at the University of Kansas now has a complete set for the entire State of this state census for the following years: 1865, 1875, 1885, 1895, 1905, and 1915. Census is available only at the State Historical Society in Topeka). The Documents Library is located in the basement of Watson Library and its normal hours are: 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, and Sunday through Thursday evenings from 7 to 10 p.m. University vacation schedules affect these times, however. Out-of-state readers of this quarterly might be interested to know that the Documents Library will lend its State census rolls on inter-library loan. Requests must come from another library on the official Inter-Library Loan forms and should be sent to: Inter-Library Loan Office, Watson Library, University of Kansas, Lawrence, Kansas, 66045. Loan period is for one week only. Please note that this applies only to the State of Kansas censuses. Patrons should borrow the Federal censuses through the nearest Federal Archives branch.

Patrons interested in genealogy should also note that the local Daughters of the American Revolution chapter and the Douglas County Genealogical Society have deposited their libraries at the Lawrence Public Library.

Finally, the Public Library now has telephone books for all U.S. cities over 53,000 in population and has compiled an index file of all smaller towns included in these books. These books contain 2/3 of the nation's population. Genealogists can compile quite complete mailing lists using this collection.
